Dr. Jennifer Snow is currently Executive Director of Teacher Pedagogy at The Royal Conservatory (RCM) and Chief Academic Officer for RCM Examinations. Most recently, she has designed and presented RCM teacher professional development across Canada and helped launch The Carnegie Hall Royal Conservatory Achievement Program in the US. She has presented at a wide range of conferences including Music Teachers National Association (MTNA), European Piano Teachers Association, College Music Society, World Piano Pedagogy Conference, National Conference on Keyboard Pedagogy, Canadian Federation of Music Teachers' Associations (CFMTA), and numerous state and provincial music teacher conferences. She is a senior examiner for The Royal Conservatory, is a clinician for The Frederick Harris Music Co., Limited, and is in demand as an adjudicator. Jennifer is a member of the Canadian Adjudicators Association, Chromatic Music Board, the CMS National Committee on Music in Higher Education, and the editorial board for American Music Teacher magazine.

In addition to her passionate commitment to teaching and teacher education, Dr. Snow is a versatile and accomplished performer who has appeared as a solo and collaborative pianist throughout Canada, the United States and Europe. She has performed with such recognised artists as Jens Lindemann of The Canadian Brass, Philip Smith of the New York Philharmonic, James Thompson of the Atlanta Symphony, Mark Gould of the Metropolitan Opera Orchestra, soloists Alain Trudel, John Griffiths, Jeremy Brown, and members of such orchestras as the LA Chamber Orchestra, Toronto Symphony, Montreal Symphony, NAC Orchestra, Calgary Philharmonic, Orchestra London and the Millar Brass Ensemble of Chicago. A diverse and active recitalist, Jennifer is heard frequently on CBC radio and has recorded for Marquis, Amberola and Phoenix Records. She has also played for the Showtime! Network, T.V. Ontario, Edmonton Symphony Orchestra series, Kilburn Artist series, Banff Centre concerts, Ottawa Chamber Music festival, Stratford Festival, and ABC Television.

Currently Jennifer is a member of the keyboard faculty at the UCLA Herb Alpert School of Music where she teaches piano, collaborative piano, and pedagogy. She has taught piano pedagogy at the Glenn Gould Professional School in Toronto and has served on the collaborative piano faculty at the prestigious Music Academy of the West in Santa Barbara, California. Previously she was a faculty member at the University of Toronto, the University of Prince Edward Island and Brock University

Jennifer received a Bachelor of Music degree in Piano Performance from the University of Western Ontario, where she graduated with honours. Pursuing graduate studies at Northwestern University, she earned a Masters of Music degree and a Doctor of Music degree. Jennifer has also been a resident artist at the Banff Centre for the Fine Arts.
